

# Great Tasting Water

Do you want to have great tasting water wherever you camp? Tired of your coffee or tea tasting different at every campground? Afraid of what might be in the water in some of the out-of-the-way locations? Well, so did I! In fact, Dianne and I usually took 12 to 16 gallons of osmosis filtered water in gallon jugs with us when we travelled in our motorhome. I hate the taste of water at some locations we have stayed and being a “coffee snob,” I wanted my coffee to taste the same no matter where I camp.

After retiring and moving into our home in Tennessee, I was not happy with the way our water tasted. Also, it was hard water and taking a bath or washing clothes was less than ideal. So, when I got a call from a water treatment company, I told them to come on out! The treatment was primarily a water softener, though they also had an osmosis filter system you could also add. When he hooked up his portable osmosis demonstrator, I commented that if we could make a cup of coffee and it tasted satisfactory, I would buy the system. It did so I bought the system and have been very happy with it since. In fact, I was filling the water jugs I took on our trips from the osmosis filter spigot. The system in our home had a 3-gallon pressure tank to build up a supply since I connected it to our ice maker and water dispenser in the fridge in addition to the spigot on the sink. Good water all around!

After a while, it was getting old filling all those bottles for our trips and finding places to store them, so I started looking for an osmosis system that would work with our system and fit in the limited area in the cabinet under the kitchen sink. One thing that would help would be to do away with the storage tank. On my home unit, it is about the same size as the 20 lb. propane tank on my home grill. The unit I came up with is the Brondell H2O+ Coral UC300 Three-Stage Undercounter Water Filtration System. You can find it on Amazon and at \$99.00 is a bargain.

To install, you will need to drill a hole in the counter for the spigot. I used a standard  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hole saw like the one used for woodworking. The Corian countertop is basically a hard plastic and drilling the hole was fast and easy. Once drilled, I just fed the blue water supply hose through the hole as per the directions and tightened the washer and nut on the bottom to make it secure. Before use, you will need to pull the plastic tab from the battery holder in the handle to activate the sensor lights.

Now you will move to under the sink to install the water supply “T” and the mount for the three-filter system. The “T” comes with adapters to be able to use with different size connectors on your coach’s cold-water supply line. I did have to use the adapters, so it was nice they were provided. My motorhome did not have water cutoffs under the sink so I shut off the water connection to the coach and turned off the water pump. Open the cold water tap to deplete the pressure and just disconnect the water line from the sink faucet and install the “T” in the line. Make sure you turn off the valve going to the osmosis filter and you can turn on the water pressure and check for leaks. All the remaining connections are Pex push-to-connect fittings which makes it easy.

To install the filter assembly, you will need to pick a location that will allow you to tilt the filters out to remove and replace when needed. The assembly can be mounted in any orientation, though they recommend vertical. The supply line goes in the top left and the filtered lines comes out of the top right. The connectors for the white supply and blue filtered lines can be mounted so they both go to the right or left. I have mine both going to the right as viewed from the face of the assembly.



# Great Tasting Water

I then attached the white supply line and mounted the assembly against the cabinet wall using two wood screws. After it was mounted, I cut the supply line to length and inserted it in the “T” fitting. Then measure the blue water line, cut to length and insert it in the remaining fitting on the assembly. I also placed the lines so they would not be in the way of items stored under the sink. The mounted and connected assembly.



Remember to cut the water lines square so they will not leak. I use this type of folding box cutter to cut them as shown.



After installation, run the water through the osmosis filter for 5 minutes to flush the lines and filters before use.

In addition to this Osmosis filter, I have added a water softener so I now have all the comforts of home.
