



## *Get Big Saving on Motorhome Trip Expenses*

Two programs you can use to save substantially on RV travel expenses have become available to CCI Members. Jeanne and I spent 4 weeks on the road from Wentzville, MO, to Santa Fe, NM, to Bend, OR, and back to Wentzville (4,000+ miles) during June/July taking advantage of both of these programs. We'll fill you in on the details and benefits in the two following articles:

**TSD/EFS Fuel Card.** We saved around 43 cents a gallon overall on our month long trip. This article will fill you in on the specifics including how to get the card and use it at the truck stop pump.

**Harvest Hosts.** Free RV Camping at 1,149+ Wineries, Breweries & Distilleries, Farms and More! What's not to like?

### *TSD/EFS Fuel Card*

Fuel is one of the biggest expenses on Motorhome trips. Filling up at the pump can be a pain in the wallet, especially when you travel a lot of miles, and drive a big motorhome, as we all do. We now have a discount fuel program that saved Jeanne and I, on our trip, up to \$70 per fill!

The following table documents our experience. Most rows are self-explanatory. Some data is missing as EFS reports are sometimes incomplete. Most dollar amounts are rounded to whole dollars.

When you stop and fuel up with your EFS Card at the truck stop you will only see the regular diesel price, which was \$1.999 at the Oak Grove, TA Truck Stop. Using the EFS Card App, before you determine where to fuel up, you will be able to determine the diesel discount price marker of all authorized Truck Stops along your route. The EFS Card App green marker will indicate the best diesel discount price on the route.

For example on the day we drove across Missouri the best EFS discount price was \$1.657 at the Oak Grove TA Truck Stop. After you complete your transaction you can go to the EFS App and find out the discount price and the fees EFS charges you, as well as stating the gallons of fuel you purchased.

Mathematically: (53.3 Gallons)(1.657 TSD Unit Fuel Price) + (\$2.470 TSD Fee Total) = \$90.79 TSD Total Fuel Fee to RVer

Pump Price minus TSD Price = Saving per Transaction or (\$106.57 - \$90.79) = \$15.78

RVer's Saving per Gallon = \$15.78/53.3 = \$0.30 a gallon

## ***How do you get the EFS Fuel Card?***

Here's how you can get in the program and start using the card. Visit the following sites for key information –

[www.tsdlogistics.com/services/fuel-program](http://www.tsdlogistics.com/services/fuel-program)

Fill out the TSD form at their secure online portal:

<https://tsdv.loadtracking.com:8443/im/fuelcardapp>. Fill in

all information, any missing or incorrect information will delay your application. TSD does require your bank account and social security number. They will not process the application without this information. Also make sure to put your address where you want the card to be mailed. Allow 3-4 weeks to receive. If you are traveling you may need to put your next location in the address. A replacement card is \$5.

If you need the card processed within 48 hours there is an additional charge of \$20. If you want it sent by Fed Ex overnight an additional fee of \$50 will be applied plus the expedited fee of \$20.

How do you use the EFS Fuel Card at the Truck Stop?


Pull into the truck line at an approved Truck Stop. Insert your EFS card into the fuel pump. A series of 8 or so prompts will ask for specific information that verifies the owner. You can "skip or cancel" all, perhaps answering "Tractor" for where your putting the fuel. When you are asked for your "Control Number" insert the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number. Once you've entered the correct information, pump your diesel & depart. Gone are the days of going into the Truck Stop building to start/complete your transaction.

Within 2-5 business days the money is drafted from your bank account and you receive an email showing you the details of the transaction and EFS fees. (There is a \$30 fee for insufficient funds and a \$15 fee for late payments.)

## ***How do you use the EFS Fuel Card App?***

- The app will keep track of all of your EFS charges and transaction details.
- The app can also show you estimated prices after discount for all locations close to you that accept EFS.
- Download and set-up the EFS Card App on your phone.

- Enter your card number & 4-digit pin. The card number is all the digits you see on the face of the card.
- The app opens with a list of recent activity. Touching on a transaction give the details.
- Selecting the 3 bars in the upper left corner gives you a choice of tools and information.
- Select “Price Locator.” You’ll find a GPS map with your current location, as well as a pin for every nearby authorized Truck Stop. Each pin gives the current discount diesel price. There will be one green pin, indicating the lowest price location. Touching the pin gives location details.
- To the upper left select the circle with arrowhead.
- Now you can do a search for the best discounted diesel fuel price for the next leg of your trip. Enter your Start Address and End Address for the upcoming drive. It usually takes the app a few seconds to collect and present the route and all the fuel locations.
- Zoom in to read all the pins.
- Select the location/details and price that meets your needs.
- Your author usually puts the desired truck stop location information into his Waze GPS app.
- You’re good to go.

## ***Harvest Hosts (HH)***

Next to diesel fuel costs, campground fees are a close second. Jeanne and I learned about the Harvest Host program in the middle of our recent trip to Santa Fe, NM, and Bend, OR. We immediately joined, paying the \$79 membership cost. As a Harvest Host Member we had access to free overnight stays at over 1,142+ incredible locations across North America. All CCI members would qualify to join.

Our first experience with Harvest Host was on our way home to Wentzville, MO, from the northwest. We used I-80 as our main route, so we looked for HH locations along/near I-80. We found 3 likely destinations spaced a suitable distance apart. We used a 250 miles drive distance. The Host locations typically have a business that encourages you to arrive early afternoon or sooner so you can sightsee the location and experience what the hosts have to offer. To us that meant arriving by 2 or 3 PM as many (not all) close at 5 PM.

Harvest Hosts members appreciate that the invitation to visit overnight is a special opportunity for you and ask that you behave respectfully. Remember that the Hosts are not campgrounds and respect their work and privacy. There is a HH *Code of Conduct* which we did not find to be unreasonable. The HH website has detailed information. We enjoyed our camping and social experiences at the locations where we stayed. The arrangement is a win-win for both the Harvest Host and the RVers. We enjoyed a pleasant afternoon/evening at the Host location without a camping fee. We purchased items we wanted to buy . So yes we still paid for our stay, but we came away with items we wanted, meet some great people, and enjoyed great food and drink.

Harvest Host has an excellent website ( <https://harvesthosts.com> ). You’ll find it easy to locate destinations, The Harvest Host sites include 4 types of locations spread across the US. The website has excellent mapping and routing functions. You won’t be disappointed.

The Saga continues. At a recent meeting the Executive BOD rejected once again the recommendation of the President, CEO Chris Smith, and Finance Committee. They had proposed to drop FMC Assist, drop Dues to \$50.00, set a contingency fund for future Conventions { Perry 2021}, pass a balanced budget. The Executive BOD has a proposed a negative budget and feel they can get it to a balanced budget without the major drastic changes that were recommended.

The things that they all seem to agree on is to knock \$80,000.00 out of the travel budget and reduce the amount clubs will pay from insurance that the Clubs like us pay for Rallies.

FMCA did receive \$556,000.00 in PPP funds due to the Pandemic, this will be forgiven if all rules and regulations are followed according to government guidelines.

As this process continues I will continue to monitor all the meetings that I'm allowed to on ZOOM and report back monthly. Pray for all involved, wish them luck, and especially hope that all egos are left out of the Meetings

Our story begins back in 1921, when Jacob and Rose Gurevich moved out to the country from Washington, DC. They bought a plot of land, started Cherry Hill Poultry Farm, and set up a general store right by the road. When travelers came through, Rose allowed them to set up camp behind the store, and the Gurevich family entered the industry of hospitality for the first time.

After World War II, the nation experienced a housing crisis. We became Cherry Hill Trailer Park, then Cherry Hill Mobile Home Village, housing many GIs and young families.

As the interstate highway system grew, Americans began to travel for leisure, and many needed a place to stay while visiting Washington, DC. Cherry Hill Campcity was born, and we became a business that catered to travelers and tourists for the first time.

In the 1980s, Rose and Jacob's grandson Norman Gurevich and his wife, Joan, had a vision for a new kind of campground: a top-tier destination park that offered premium amenities, extensive services, full hook-ups, and room for even the biggest RVs. We built Cherry Hill Park from scratch, moving one mile down the road from our original location.

2 generations later, we've officially settled into our new location, and we are still focused on continuing to grow and change to accommodate the needs of our guests. In 2015, we completed another major renovation, adding a splash park, premium log cabins, 18-hole mini golf, a new bath-house, a gym, an outdoor pavilion, new laundry facilities, and group tenting sites. In 2017, we were fortunate to win our third Campground of the Year award from ARVC (also 2007 & 2002). We enjoy outstanding ratings from Good Sam, as well as from guest review sites like Google, TripAdvisor, and Campground Reviews.

Through all of the changes, we've stayed rooted in the same values we held as a family of farmers. We're proud to work hard and to put smiles on the faces of those we serve. We focus each day on providing our guests with the best hospitality and tourism options that Washington, DC, has to offer.
