# “We Visit Savannah, An Historic Treasure”

Oct 14-19, 2020

October is one of the best times of the year to visit Savannah, offering pleasantly warm, dry weather and a wealth of things to do.

Emerging as a great city of the South in the 1800s, Savannah remains an historic treasure. The cobblestoned historic district is highlighted by popular community “squares” and manicured parks, magnificently shaded by magnolia blossoms and oak trees covered with Spanish moss. Horse-drawn carriages and ornate antebellum architecture add to the rich ambiance. Twenty-two of Savannah’s original squares still exist, dating back to the city’s founding in 1733.



# Tech Tip - Improve Dry Camping Capability

**Question:** How can I improve my dry camping capability?

**Answer:**

The simplest answer, and by far the most economical, is to reduce your use of the coach's electrical system. Here are some suggestions:

1. Turn off the inverter when AC power is not required. Although the inverter has an energy saving idle or 'search' mode, in practice it never activates due to parasitic loads such as the microwave clock and 'standby circuits' in TV's and VCR's, etc. Turning the inverter off when you are sleeping, for example, can gain you as much as three to four hours of dry camping time. When plugged in, the inverter can safely remain on.
2. Avoid or limit your use of AC heat producing appliances such as small heaters, the microwave, toasters, curling irons, and coffee makers, etc. If making coffee, just make enough for one cup each and then turn the coffee maker off to prevent the 'hot plate' from discharging your batteries further. A microwave, for example, can pull over 130 amps from the batteries in use.
3. Avoid using bay freezers when dry camping, but if necessary, these should be powered by 12V with the temperature setting adjusted to a minimum.
4. When using your propane or diesel heating system, reduce the temperature settings and use warmer clothing or bedding.
5. Turn off any lights and fans, etc. that are not being used. If the icemaker in your refrigerator runs on inverter power, then this should also be turned off.

An important consideration when recharging your batteries is how long the generator will have to run to obtain a full charge. For heavily discharged batteries, this can vary from three hours for two 8D liquid cell batteries, to over ten hours for four AGM batteries. Owners of coaches with larger battery banks will unlikely run their generator long enough to fully charge their batteries and therefore usually experience reduced dry camping time after their initial arrival.

If your budget allows, installing solar panels will significantly increase dry camping time, and the energy they produce is free, silent, and environmentally friendly. Solar panels do have a limited output however, so maximum gains will be achieved when they are used in conjunction with the energy saving suggestions above.

# FMCA Update

At the end of June 2020 the FMCA Finance Committee was in the process of submitting a budget to the Executive Board. That budget was rejected by Jon Walker, it was a negative \$215,000.00. He would not accept that and sent the Finance Committee back to the drawing board.

On Tuesday, July 14 2020, there was a Finance Committee Zoom meeting which I was able to view, but could not participate in the meeting. They made several recommendations that would be considered by the Executive Board in the next meeting directly after the Finance Committee meeting.

The Executive Board was called to order and a motion was made to postpone the vote on the new proposals until the Executive Board had the opportunity to look at the total budget in a workshop and then have a few days before the Executive Board would have a formal meeting to vote it in or vote it down.

Here are the Proposals given to the Executive Board to consider:

\* Drop FMCAssist for at least the rest of this year and to look at other options. This is a \$900,000.00 expense.

\* Reduce the Dues to \$50.00 a year and for those that paid the \$75.00 they would receive credit for additional months.

\* Cut approximately \$80,000.00 out of the travel budget for President, Executive Board, and Committee Members.

These are RECOMMENDATIONS ONLY nothing has passed as yet.

The Executive Board has tasked the administration to give some realistic figures to the potential loss of members due to the pandemic and the drop of FMCAssist. The drop of FMCAssist could be as many as 25,000 members. We all know that we have lost about 4,000 members since last October, the beginning of the physical year.

The next meetings will be on Zoom and you can rest assured I will be on that meeting and report back to you.

In the 1980s, Rose and Jacob's grandson Norman Gurevich and his wife, Joan, had a vision for a new kind of campground: a top-tier destination park that offered premium amenities, extensive services, full hook-ups, and room for even the biggest RVs. We built Cherry Hill Park from scratch, moving one mile down the road from our original location.

2 generations later, we've officially settled into our new location, and we are still focused on continuing to grow and change to accommodate the needs of our guests. In 2015, we completed another major renovation, adding a splash park, premium log cabins, 18-hole mini golf, a new bathhouse, a gym, an outdoor pavilion, new laundry facilities, and group tenting sites.
