





Door County Rally Report

Sixty-four CCI members gathered at Baileys Grove Campground in Bailey's Harbor, Wisconsin, June 21-26, 2019. Lee and Jeanne Zaborowski teamed with Tammy and Rick Toalson to plan and host five days of exciting events. We had a great time!

The Rally started on Summer Solstice, Friday, June 21st.

Of the 32 couples; 8 Club Board Members attended and we had 9 first-timer couples. The Friday dinner/evening time was filled with a Social Hour, Dinner and Welcome

Orientation. The opening meal was an awesome beef brisket and sides, prepared and served by Chef Amy Rebhan and her staff. Amy capped the dinner with a hallmark Door County dessert . . . Cherry Pie. Of the many things that have made Door County famous, cherries are right up there on the list.



Each venue/tour was led by a Docent or Host, assuring we'd get the most out of what we saw at that destination.

Saturday, June 22nd, focused on free time to explore Door County followed by an evening at the Peninsula Playhouse.

Saturday is "Fair and Festival Day" on Summer Saturdays. Rally attendees spent the time exploring a variety of town events.

Peninsula Playhouse Performances are held rain or shine in an all-weather pavilion along the shores of Green Bay. The theater's sides could be raised or lowered, depending on the weather; allowing for a breathtaking view of the cedar forest, gardens and waterfront. Mother Nature is the lobby at Peninsula Players. We were able to stroll paths along



the cedar-lined forest, visit the theater's outdoor beer garden, and watch a sunset over the shores of Green Bay before settling into our seats

for the latest Players' fare presented by nationally recognized actors. The comedy we saw kept us laughing throughout the evening.



Sunday, June 23rd, was a morning to evening day full of tours, views, refreshments, and local delicacies.

The morning was dominated by the Door County Trolley's "Bloody Mary and Brunch Tour," a Wisconsin tradition. We enjoyed a beautiful 3.5 hour guided tour with narrative in 3 chauffeured trolleys, along the way partaking in stops for a traditional Sunday Brunch and Bloody Mary's, Mimosa's, beer or non alcoholic beverages. The group later split to all parts of Door County for the afternoon.



That evening we all reconvened at the White Gull Inn in Fish Creek. The Inn is an historic Bed and Breakfast Inn and Restaurant open to the public, offering lodging with character and award-winning dining since 1896. The White Gull Inn is famous for its traditional Door County fish boils, featuring Lake Michigan whitefish. This specialty, caught by local fishermen is cooked outside over an open fire, just as it was one hundred years ago by the Scandinavian settlers of the Peninsula. Fresh fish is cut in chunks and cooked in boiling water with small red potatoes. Salt is the only spice used. Fish oils rise to the surface of the boiling cauldron, and when the fish is perfectly done, the Master Boiler tosses

a small amount of kerosene on the flames under the pot. The great burst of flames causes the boilover, spilling the fish oils over the sides of the pot and leaving the fish steaming hot and ready to serve. Inside, the fish and potatoes are served with sides including homemade Door County cherry pie for dessert. It was a grand day!



Monday, June 24th, we bused to Lambeau Field for the morning, Door County Maritime Museum for the afternoon.

Our *Lambeau Field Stadium Tour* gave us a chance to experience the Packers' history-rich facility first-hand and see several behind-the-scenes areas. Throughout the tour we learned about the incredible history of the *Green Bay Packers* and felt the indomitable spirit and impassioned energy that makes the Packers and Lambeau Field so endearing. It was a grand tour. Everyone had outstanding photo opportunities. We began in the Atrium, where this group photo was taken.



Up on the upper decks we saw the Premium Seating Areas on the East Side of Lambeau Field, including great views of the field. As a group we charged (sort of) on to the

field, experiencing what the players experience when they run up the tunnel to the roars (piped in for us) of the crowd. We lunched in one of the stadium cafeterias before busing to the *Door County Maritime Museum*.

Located along Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin's busy waterfront, the *Door County Maritime Museum* showcased the area's rich maritime roots. Hard-working fishermen, brave ship captains, skilled craftsmen, bold inventors and lonely lighthouse keepers are just some of the personalities we learned of in the galleries of the museum. Displays showed how these maritime pioneers worked and what they made.

After touring the museum we had a guided tour of the John Purves Tug. In December 1956, Roen Steamship Company of Sturgeon Bay purchased the John Purves and put her to work on all five Great Lakes taking on towing and salvage jobs. The Purves was well known throughout the Great Lakes for her strength and towing capabilities. In fact, due to



her might, she made a good living after the opening of the St. Lawrence Seaway, rescuing many a saltwater vessel that ran aground in the tricky channels of the Great Lakes.

Tuesday, June 25th, pastries, CCI Club Meeting and Tech Talk Session took the morning; an afternoon of shopping and sightseeing ended with closing out the rally with a Social Hour, Dinner sponsored by SkyMed, and a Charity Raffle.

Our President Bill Sax lead a well attended CCI Club meeting to start the day. See Bill's President's Column in this eNews for the highlights. Jim Tome of *Kleen Tank* presented an interesting and informative session, "RV Holding Tank Maintenance."

The charity raffle we supported that night was the The Ellie Helm Foundation. Our donations supported three causes and programs:


- * Support educational opportunities & positive life skills development for youth;

CCI Standing Rules Change - CCI Alumni

We are blessed being able to drive our coaches all over the country visiting family, friends, and places on our “bucket list.” With that being said, there is the opportunity for so much more from your association with CCI. If you have not attended a CCI rally, you need to add this to your “must do” list.

The ownership of a Country Coach is the common thread that brings us together, but it is the friendships that are created at rallies and other events that keep us together. I have been a member of CCI for 14 years and during this time have seen several members leave the club because they no longer feel comfortable driving a big coach. The friendships that were created over the years need to continue even if the coach has been sold.

Your CCI Board last month amended our “CCI Standing Rules” to strengthen our friendships by creating a “CCI Alumni” designation. The amendment to our Standing Rules reads as follows:

General

12. Country Coach Alumni is a lifetime designation reserved for MEMBERS of CCI who are in good standing at the time they no longer qualify for membership in CCI. ALUMNI are exempt from paying annual dues and may attend CCI events at the Member’s price.






