




CCI Tech Info

42 Kwikiee Steps that Won't Go In By Buddy Bordes & Scott Loftfield

So you are traveling in your Motorcoach and you make a stop and your steps won't go in? Your alarm isn't working? Bay doors won't lock? Step light doesn't work?



There is a way to prevent some of these issues. Start with the wire harness that goes through the door jamb. This is typically a double insulated grey wire. The wires in this harness are very small and prone to breaking due to the cable being crimped when the door closes.

If yours has not broken yet, it will. You can stop this by taking the door panel off and installing a spring to pull your harness back into the door as the door closes.

A simple spring from a hardware store about 4 inches long with enough strength to pull the harness taut is what you need. Attach the spring to the harness using a plastic cable clamp. Then drill a small hole in the bracket inside the door (your coach may differ) to put the other end of the spring. It will take some experimenting to get the tension adjusted properly so that the cable retracts into the door as it closes.

Please take it from me. These are the steps I took before I found the problem. If the steps are not coming in on series 42 Kwikiee, drop the bottom plate under your steps, which requires removal of about 6 sheet metal screws. If possible take a picture of the system before removing the linkage bars. Then remove the 2 support linkage bars that will allow your steps to be retracted (4 bolts). Tie wrap the steps in. This should get you on the road until you can troubleshoot the problem.

Troubleshooting the issue. It could be a bad motor, control module or as in my case a bad wire in the harness in the door jamb. Remove the door panel, which allows access to the push button switch in the door that activates the steps. Every time I pushed the button the steps worked but when I closed the door sometimes the steps wouldn't operate. In my case after many steps of troubleshooting it turned out to be the broken wire in the door jamb referenced above. In my harness there was enough slack to allow me to cut out the broken segment, attach a new spade connector and then attach it to the terminal board in the door.

When you try to put the linkage bars back in, for me I could not get them back in with the motor extended. It required disconnecting the motor wiring harness half way through the cycle which has some safety issues. The other way is to remove the motor which takes more time. Put the linkage back in, and everything worked fine.

Hope this helps someone on the road.
